Brief from School Principal

- Dehradun is an educational hub. Our school is located in the educational and industrial belt of Dehradun. The economy has been badly affected as the schools and colleges are shut since March but online learning continues. Schools have opened from 2nd of November, while colleges are yet to open. Factories also were initially shut down during the lock down period. As the factories are not in full production they are calling staff for only ½ the time.
- Our parents belong to the lower middle class group and are hard hit by Covid-19.
- The parents mentioned above are the ones worst hit. Though most are facing problems.
- The Vice-Principal of the school Mrs. Vinita Chetri is in close contact with the parents and talks to them regularly.
- The Government has only allowed the school to take tuition fees. The school strictly adhered to this norm.
- Also the school has not fired any staff member and is paying full salaries to all. We have used our savings. Also unstinting effort by the Vice Principal has ensured that we are able to make the staff salaries.
- We would like to organize a Zoom meeting for all parents at a given time. This could be video -taped and played to prospective donors.
